
Christmas Bring & Buy Sale (for parents) on Friday 28th November

The hall will be transformed into a mini Christmas Bazaar, recreating the type of traditional Infant School Christmas celebrations that we as parents grew up with when we were young.

There will be a café and various festive stalls, run by School Staff. Children will have the opportunity to make traditional Christmas decorations and crafts that they will then be able to take home with them.

There will also be a 'bring and buy stall' – where children will be able to 'buy back' toy and book donations. All children in attendance will have the opportunity to have their photograph taken with Father Christmas, which will be available for you to purchase at a later date for £2.00.

Children really enjoy our Christmas Fun Days and they also gain a valuable insight into the principles of shopping and budgeting like grown-ups.
