I am excited to let you know that on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> February, between 8:45am-11am, we will be holding an Open Day/Morning for all of our current Parents and Carers.

**We really want to show you, if possible, what happens in School on an “everyday” day to day basis.**

The provision here at Thames View Infants is Exceptional and we would like to share with you what that looks and “feels like” after you drop your child off at our Academy each day.

Our Open Day is different to our family “Learning Together” sessions. It’s more of a ‘fly on the wall’ type experience where you can come in and observe a variety of lessons across school – from



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Nursery all the way up to Year 2 – and not just within your child's class. We will help provide you with a narrative as to what is going on and explain the learning taking place. We will help usher you around school and signpost you to different lessons/year groups and answer questions about our provision. It will be a great opportunity for you to see exactly what learning is like throughout our School.

On the day, you will come into the school hall at 8:45am, having dropped off your child.

### **Time-Table For The Morning**

#### **8:45am – Presentation by Adam – Internet Safety – How We Keep Our Children Safe Online**

At 9am there will be a brief presentation by Adam on Internet Safety focusing on how you can help keep your child safe online and how we keep the children safe online whilst in School.

#### **9:10am – 10:30am Parents/Carers Look Around School**

You will be free to walk around school from 9:10am, observing lessons and seeing how the children use the internet to aid their Learning in School. Adam and I will be around to answer any questions.

**Please note that there will be strictly no admission to the Open Day after 8:50am, so if you'd like to attend, please make sure that you are on time!**

Please note:

1. Sadly, due to space restrictions, we are limited to two family members per family only.
2. Mobile phones will not be allowed (as we want the children to not be distracted and for you to see, as much as possible, what happens "normally").
3. For safety reasons, buggies will also not be allowed in School.
