- You may also wish to bring a picnic blanket.
- Children should wear their normal school uniform. Please ensure they wear suitable footwear — trainers for dry weather or wellington boots if it has been raining.
- Please bring a sun hat and sun cream if warm weather is forecast.
- Please bring a raincoat if rain is expected.
- The expectation is that you depart from and return to School together with Sam and Adam. You will stay together, throughout the whole day, as a group. (You won't be allowed to wander off or leave early, for example).
- We'll be leaving at 9:15am prompt so please be here on time. If you are late, we may leave without you. We expect to return to school by 3:15 pm.
- You will be responsible for your own travel expenses so please bring a means of contactless payment with you. Children under 5 travel free.

We really appreciate your support in helping to make this visit a great success. We are very excited about sharing this special experience with the children and hope you will be able to join us.

Closer to the time, we'll be having a meeting in Nursery in order to fine tune our arrangements for this special day. However, in the meantime, if you have any questions, please come in and speak to a member of our Nursery team and they'll do their best to help.
